We Do Business in Accordance With the Federal Fair Housing Law

(The Fair Housing Amendments Act of 1988)

All of our apartments feature the following accessibility features:

- 1. An accessible building entrance on an accessible route
- 2. Accessible common and public use areas
- 3. Usable interior doors with a 32" opening
- 4. An accessible path into and through the dwelling unit
- 5. Light switches, electrical outlets, thermostats, and other environmental controls in accessible locations
- 6. Reinforced walls in bathrooms for later installation of grab bars
- 7. Usable kitchens and bathrooms

We also provide the following modifications at no cost to our residents prior to move in (if applicable):

- 1. Modify sliding glass doors to a nominal 32" clear opening
- 2. Modify thresholds leading to patios
- 3. Increase width of interior passage doors
- 4. Alter height of light switches, thermostats and outlets to ensure they are no higher than 48"
- 5. Modify bathroom countertops to ensure 48-inch by 30-inch clear floor space is parallel to and centered on the basin at 24 inches.
